Guest lecture by Dr. Charlotte Pearson, University of Arizona

This talk will introduce the development of tree-ring records from archaeological sites in the American Southwest and the Ancient Mediterranean and show how recent improvements in high precision radiocarbon analysis, combined with tree-ring techniques and the integration of both archaeological and paleoenvironmental evidence can yield improved chronological precision to aid our understanding of past human and environmental interactions.
